Approval of Minutes from Last Meeting

Last meeting's minutes were circulated and accepted.

RAM Reports

Chair Report

- Welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- Chair introduced RAM Richmond Association for Montessori
 - o You are part of RAM if your son/daughter attends the Montessori program in one of the 3 Montessori Schools.
 - RAM is funded by Membership and Donations; families whose kids attend Montessori programs. We work with the schools and the admin team trying to make the most of our subsidies to support the classroom materials and furniture.

- RAM has subsidized each year \$5,000 per school (currently at a reduced \$3,000 due to pandemic and lower fundraising) that goes towards Montessori materials and supplies, Montessori specific classroom furnishings, teacher training and education, Montessori parent night, and students' scholarship etc.
- o About 6 years ago the school district offered to subsidize some of the material and programs thus budgeted at \$4,500 per school.
- o RAM doesn't interfere with staffing, how the class is conducted, etc.
- Vivian asked what kind of license the teachers hold in the Montessori program? Montessori teachers typically hold Montessori certificates or Master's degrees, and they may also receive peer training..
- Jacquline and Ivy met with Nancy Brennan, consultant, hired by the school board who spoke with them as well as Montessori school teachers to identify any gaps or Montessori specific needs.
- The RAM fiscal year ends on August 15th, so schools need to submit expenses for reimbursement before we close the books.

Treasurer Report and Budget Discussion

- Jacqueline reviewed financial reports.
- Total Income 5K.
- Total Operating Income: \$1.9k (still waiting on school expenses, leading to a deficit of 744.16).
- Balance Sheet Total Assets \$46K.

Motion: Accepted Income Statement and Balance Sheet as presented. Motion: Accepted 2024/2025 Budget as presented.

Open Issues and New Business

Scholarship and Bursaries

• RAM received 7 applicants from 5 high schools, grade 12 students, who graduated from the Montessori program. They are eligible for a \$500 scholarship.

- Students were asked to write 500 words; a testimonial on how the Montessori program benefited them in highschool, post secondary education and life in general?
- Decided to increase the budget to \$700, since there were no bursaries. Two Scholarships for \$300 and one Scholarship for \$100. Congrats!!
- Potential discussion regarding \$25 honorable gift cards for two additional applicants as encouragement.

Fundraising

Bursaries

Summary of how the bursary program works:

- RAM has \$3000 general pool to ensure fair allocation.
- For multi-year Montessori programs:
 - 1st year: Reimbursement up to \$1000.
 - 2nd year: Up to \$1200 with proof of enrollment.
 - 3rd year: Up to \$1500.
- For workshops, the maximum reimbursement is \$500.
- Mentorship activities range from \$300 to \$500.

Applications are accepted year-round and reviewed by our executives during meetings for pre-approval. Once pre-approved, we proceed with the reimbursement process.

- This year we had one mentorship request that involved covering the cost of a Teacher-on-Call (TOC) for half a day, which is \$275. It was preapproved.
- Two bursaries of \$500 each were approved to two seasoned Montessori teachers who are pursuing their master's degrees in Montessori education. Percentage of time dedicated to a Montessori classroom reflected in prorated bursary eligibility. Approved and no objections.
